3	£7	£9	£26	San Giorgio Pinot Grigio <i>Italy</i> Award winning Pinot Grigio which actually delivers and is crafted by the now famous Pasqua family. Clean, crisp with loads of flavour all the way from Venezie.
4	£7	£9	£26	Lacrimus Tempranillo Blanco Spain This wine shows beautifully pale straw with intense aromas of tropical fruits and citric nuances.
5	£7	£9	£26	<b>7even Sauvignon Blanc</b> <i>South Africa</i> Crisp and fresh the wine is bursting with green tropical fruit aromas, grapefruit and fig on the nose. The palate is juicy and packed with flavour.
6			£29	Levre Piquante Picpoul de Pinet France Unashamedly fresh and citrussy. The palate is lively, zesty and impossible to dislike. Great with fish and seafoods, as the locals enjoy it.
7			£29.75	The Tin Mine White South Africa Complex aromatics of apricot, white pear and citrus with floral undertones and hints of oak spice. A blend from Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay, Roussanne, Semillon and Viognier grapes.
8	£9	£п	£32	Turnbull & Thomas Sauvignon Blane New Zealand Marlborough Sauvignon as we love it, crisp and fresh with beautiful balance and fruit characters to linger on the palate. Well worth the upgrade!

IO	£36	Joel Gott Pinot Gris USA White peach aromas with floral notes. On the palate, the wine is balanced, opening with bright acidity and refreshing Meyer lemon citrus flavours, followed by a juicy mid-palate, and a long finish.
II	£45	Salz 'Figaro' Grüner Veltliner <i>Austria</i> Rich, bright green-yellow with juicy fruit aromas of ripe apple, stone fruit, and herbal notes. Crisp and dense on the palate with white pepper, minerality, and a long-lasting finish of grapefruit and apple.
12	£50	Chablis L'Onciale France The benchmark of classic Chablis, firm and steely lemon hints with intense minerality and a juicy long finish from Chardonnay grapes.
13	£55	Sancerre Blanc, Raffaitin-Planchon France In a small Loire Valley hamlet named Amigny, Jean-Claude and his son Antoine farm 25 acres, delivering floral wines with structure and fuller body with a zesty mineral component.
14	£60	Clos de Chevigne Saint Veran Boise Les Morats France Aroma reveals a subtle interplay of ripe fruits and yellow-fleshed fruits, contributing to a nuanced and refined aromatic profile offering a substantial mouthfeel that suggests richness and depth. A discernible hint of oak adds complexity, providing additional layers of flavour.
15	£75	<b>Louis Latour Pouilly-Fuisse</b> <i>France</i> Hand-picked Chardonnay grapes from 30-year old vines, resting on its lees for 8 to 10 months. Round balanced revealing beautiful exotic fruit aromas, expressive and fresh

22	£29.50	Paolo Leo Passitivo Appassimento Primitivo <i>Italy</i> Organic. A gorgeous complex bouquet, cherries, raspberries and redcurrants and a beautiful oak aging, delivering a roasted and spicy aroma. A full-bodied, supple and well-balanced red delicious!
23	£34	Napa Cellar Pinot Noir California, USA Beautiful fruitful aromas of dark cherries, cranberries and strawberry preserves with subtle tobacco notes. Excellent mouthfeel with soft and supple tannins and firm acid structure, complete with a balanced finish.

24	£36	Château Lestage Simon France The nose of this red wine from Bordeaux charms with nuances of mulberry, blackberry, blueberry and blackcurrant. Starts out wonderfully dry, grippy and aromatic, this punchy red wine features an immensely fleshy texture that captivates.
25	£37	Gouguenheim Reserve Malbec Argentina Deep purple in colour with aromas of red fruits, chocolate and coffee beans. Red and black cherry flavours with scents of violets. Smooth with some complexity.
26	£52	Neirano Barolo DOCG <i>Italy</i> Unquestionably, one of the finest and most prestigious wines of the world! The Nebbiolo grape gives the wine great body, character and rich majestic style. Deep in colour, delicate aroma, a vanilla note and full flavour.
27	£62	Santenay Rouge Louis Latour France A beautiful Pinot Noir from the most southerly village in Cote de Beaune, Burgundy. Reveals aromas of blackcurrant and morello cherry notes while on the palate, it is beautifully aromatic and delicate with silky tannins and a beautiful persistence.
28	£82	Château Laroque, Grand Cru Classé France Enchanting deep and dark colour, almost black. Rich and intense nose with delicious black fruits aromas. On the palate the attack is powerful, generous and smooth. The tannins are fleshy and tasty. Really harmonious with a mineral touch finish that reinforces its aromatic freshness. A fantastic Bordeaux from St Emilion.
29	£89	Rombauer Twin Rivers' Zinfandel, 2019 <i>USA</i> A true wildcard on our wine list. Ultrasmooth in texture and impressively ripe in flavour, this very full-bodied single vineyard wine from El Dorado in the Sierra Foothills offers tempting, almost-sweet, blackberry and dried plum flavours, shaded by light woodsmoke, chocolate and black pepper. Extremely difficult to find outside the US.
30	£98	Jean-Michel Guillon Gevrey-Chambertain, 2017 France From the head of a beautiful estate of nearly 14 hectares of vines that stretch over Gevrey, Chambolle, Vougeot, Santenay and Marsannay. This very special Burgundy is quite a dark colour with nose of liquorice and black fruits. A powerful wine, with fatness, freehness and a rather long finish
